Being a By-law to Amend Noise By-law 2023-88

(Noise By-law Amendment)

Whereas Council of the Corporation of the Township of Algonquin Highlands enacted By-law 2023-88 to regulate Noise within the Boundaries of the Township of Algonquin Highlands on the 5th day of October 2023.

As Whereas it is deemed necessary to amend By-law No. 2023-88, being the By-law to regulate Noise within the Boundaries of the Township of Algonquin Highlands.

And Whereas Section 434.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, and amendments thereto enables the councils of local municipalities to establish a system of administrative penalties.

And Whereas Section 434.2 establishes an administrative penalty constitutes a debt of the person which may be added to the tax roll;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Algonquin Highlands enacts as follows:

- 1. By amending Section 2 Definitions adding the following definition:
 - x) Administrative Monetary Penalty System: means a monetary penalty imposed for a contravention of a Designated By-law and as set out in Township's Administrative Monetary Penalty System (AMPS) By-law, as amended.
- 2. By re-ordering the following sections:
 - 7. Enforcement to 8. Enforcement
 - 8. Obstruction to 9. Obstruction
 - 9. Validity & Severability to 10. Validity & Severability
 - 10. Repeals to 11. Repeals
 - 11. Effective Date to 12. Effective Date
- 3. Adding the following section:
 - 7. Administrative Monetary Penalties
 - 7.1 Every Person who contravenes a provision of this By-law shall upon the issuing of a Penalty Notice under Township's Administrative Monetary System By-law, as amended is liable to pay the Township an Administrative Monetary Penalty.
