**Being a By-law to Amend Parking By-law 2022-76**

(Parking By-law Amendment)

**Whereas** Council of the Corporation of the Township of Algonquin Highlands enacted By-law 2022-76 to Regulate and Control Parking and Traffic on Township Roadways under the Jurisdiction of the Township of Algonquin Highlands on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 2022.

**And Whereas** it is deemed necessary to amend By-law No. 2022-76, being the By-law to Regulate and Control Parking and Traffic on Township Roadways under the Jurisdiction of the Township of Algonquin Highlands.

**And Whereas** Section 434.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, and amendments thereto enables the councils of local municipalities to establish a system of administrative penalties and whereas.

**And Whereas** Section 434.2 establishes an administrative penalty constitutes a debt of the person which may be added to the tax roll;

**And Whereas** pursuant to O. Reg. 333/07: Administrative Penalties, under the Municipal Act, a municipality may establish a system of administrative penalties respecting the parking, standing, or stopping of vehicles.

**Now Therefore** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Algonquin Highlands enacts as follows:

1. By amending 2.0 – Definitions adding the following definition:

2.35 **Administrative Monetary Penalty System:** means a monetary penalty imposed for a contravention of a Designated By-law and as set out in Township's Administrative Monetary Penalty System (AMPS) By-law, as amended.

2. By amending the following Sections by re-ordering:

16.0 – Conflict to 17.0 – Conflict

17.0 – Severability to 18.0 – Severability

18.0 – Repeal to 19.0 – Repeal


19.0 – Effective Date to 20.0 – Effective Date


And adding the following section:

**16.0 Administrative Monetary Penalties**

16.1 Every Person who contravenes a provision of this By-law shall upon the issuing of a Penalty Notice under Township's Administrative Monetary System By-law, as amended is liable to pay the Township an Administrative Monetary Penalty.
